### WiCII Provider Education Meeting with WISMHI Thursday, April 9, 2020, 3p

**Attendees:** Gail, Anne, Nicole (Waisman); Geeta and Naomi (WISMHI)

#### Minutes:

1. As we develop provider education for the project, want to coordinate with our partners along the way to make sure we are not duplicating
2. WISMHI has one potential training with a clinic coming up, all others have been postponed or cancelled
3. WiCII team has familiarized self with CME, MOC parts 2 and 4, and other continuing education credits
4. WISMHI is planning on re-evaluating trainings and types of credits they offer to make sure they are meeting provider needs
5. WISMHI plans to review the new guidelines and update trainings as appropriate (times of screenings have changed, more referrals recommended) – typically do this on an annual basis or as recommendations change
6. May make sense for Nicole and Naomi to review the content of the developmental screening training curriculum to make sure we align our trainings and are not duplicative
7. Though up until now, WISMHI has done trainings in-person, they are open to exploring other modes of delivery – however, the in-person connection is important for relationship building
8. We want to work together to maximize our efforts, best reach the most practices across WI
9. WiCII is still using the ECQuIP model to support local QI
10. Where do we start?
  - a. Anne suggested setting up series of meetings to review existing curriculum and maybe work together to develop a virtual version of the WISMHI trainings
  - b. Gail – identifying the “layers” of what we need to do, seeing where resources exists, and prioritize what still needs to be done or updated
11. For the large MOC part 4 QI project, need to think about where we would want the data to go – WCHQ is already collecting some relevant data (but not in a way that will meet our needs and do not provide MOC4 credit)

#### Action Items:

1. Nicole/Gail will confirm ECHO Autism schedule and get Naomi and Geeta included in those meetings
2. Gail will start writing down the “layers” of what is available for clinics to build their capacity
3. Naomi will send Anne and Gail the link to the Vimeo and power point of the existing training
4. Nicole will send the articles related to the updated guidelines to Geeta and Naomi
5. Everyone will review the various materials before the next meeting
6. Naomi is going to see if she can find Arianna's info on the difference between MOC part 2 and CME
7. Nicole will set up meeting that also includes Leah Ludlum after April 23<sup>rd</sup> for an hour and a half
