Action Items from September meeting:

1. Nicole will follow up with Barbara Katz or Deb Gerlach to see if we can get info on any assessments used by ASHEW
2. Naomi will share the knowledge assessment tool with the team, Anne will share any assessments she has
3. Nicole/Gail will reach out the WIAAP to see if they are interested in collaborating on the Developmental Grand Rounds
4. Nicole will identify a standing monthly time for our group to meet

1. Review Action Items from September & decide on key topics to cover today
2. Provider Ed Updates
 - a. WiCII -
 - i. Developmental Grand Rounds
 1. We are developing in response to feedback from providers that updates on development would be helpful in a grand rounds format
 2. WIAAP is going to co-sponsor
 3. WISMHI uses Medical College of WI as the accredited agency to provide CME
 4. Planned format is 20 min didactic, 20 min presentation from someone that's put topic in practice, 20 min discussion/Q&A
 5. Leah – ABC for Health quick hitters (5 min online webinars on specific topics) have been very popular – may be worth following similar model
 6. In the next couple of months we should reach out to the WI Family Practice professional org about partnering in addition to WIAAP
 7. The Act Early State team also just added a family practice physician, Nicole and Gail will reach out to her as well
 8. We should also consider how to reach nurse practitioners and physician assistants – we will start with physicians and then
 9. Naomi – HMO is requiring a suite of trainings for its practitioners to obtain certification. Requirement includes developmental screening as well as mental health and substance use – may foreshadow future requirements. Unclear if this going to be a requirement for all HMOs in WI. They have reached out to WISMHI for assistance on developmental screening training.
 10. Gail – would be great if we could package social-emotional, and behavioral screening along with the developmental screening training since this is what guidelines recommend
 - a. Updates on completed site visits with clinics
 - i. We did these virtually this year, but plan to do in person in future years
 - ii. Meetings involved clinic staff, Birth to 3 and other community partners, and family leaders
 - iii. Sites are not identifying the number of kids with concerns that we would expect based on their volume. At this point, it's unclear whether this is because they are not screening as well as we expected or if there are issues in the referral process
 - iv. We quickly developed the assessment as a way for us to identify where there are gaps, we could partner with Naomi and/or provider ed group to refine this tool for future use
 - v. Because of Covid, clinics are really not seeming like they are willing or able to engage in improving screening, referral, and follow-up processes at this point
 - vi. We have not yet been able to complete a site visit with Ascension due to a number of staff changes

3. We will revisit the chart we were working on to map current provider ed resources – can be found in Teams

Action Items:

2. Nicole will share WiCII site visit tool with team
3. Nicole will schedule meeting with Naomi and Anne to discuss how to move forward with CME for developmental grand rounds
4. Nicole and Gail will connect with the new family practice physician on the Act Early State Team about partnering on Grand Rounds
5. Naomi is going to get more information from the HMO and Arianna about the new training requirements and needs
6. Naomi will coordinate a meeting to discuss new HMO training
