### Action Items:

- Leah will ask Sharon if she knows the developmental screening champion on the Medicaid regulations planning group and explore if/how it makes sense for us to connect with this person
- Leah will follow-up with Naomi and let her know what she finds out with Sharon
- Nicole and Danielle will develop and implement plan to promote the grand rounds to multiple professions and HMOs
- Nicole and Gail will coordinate planning meetings for developmental screening training efforts related to the new HMO regulations

### Notes:

- HMO
  - Naomi has a phone call scheduled with Mike O'Leary later today
  - Mike shared the info for his contact at Medicaid
    - When we reach out to him, provide context on our goals re: developmental screening and then express interest in learning more about these new regulations.
  - Arianna is on the Medicaid regulations planning group. She has indicated that there's someone in the group who is a champion for developmental screening.
    - Sharon may be connected to this person, Leah will ask Sharon about this person
    - We will wait to follow up with the contact Mike shared with Naomi until Leah touches base with Sharon
- Developmental Grand Rounds (DGR)
  - Gail, Danielle, Anne, Lynn and Nicole have been meeting to plan what these sessions will look like
  - We may change the name to make it clearer to the variety of professions we are targeting
  - Nicole and Danielle have been meeting with UW ICEP to coordinate CME and MOC part 2, the application is under review by ICEP
    - The planning committee needs to include people from each of the professions for which we are providing credit. We are working on pulling in representatives from participating WiCII clinics
  - We are still working on defining the purpose
  - Format will be 1 hour – 20 min didactic, 20 min practical example from someone who has experience implementing, 20 min Q&A
  - We will target and provide credit to pediatricians, family practice providers, physician assistants, nurses
    - On the planning committee, we are asking Diane Gerlach to represent peds, Joanna Bisgrove for family practice, Brian Quick for PAs and a nurse at Waisman for nurses (may ask Geeta if this nurse is not available)
  - We will need to figure out how to best advertise to family medicine, PAs, and nurses by reaching out to their professional associations. Nicole and Danielle will take the lead on this
    - Larry Pfiesser is the contact for AAFP
    - CCHP may be another venue we could use to reach out to multiple professions
    - We could promote the grand rounds at a WCHQ meeting to reach HMOs - WCHQ Adolescent & Child improvement team meets on the third Monday of the month at 1-2pm
    - CPCP team would also be good to reach out to
    - Naomi will ask Mike O'Leary if he has suggestions for how to promote with HMOs

- As we promote, we need to be thoughtful about emphasizing the applicability of the grand rounds to the providers' work and how it can be beneficial to them. In our messaging be thoughtful about need to know vs nice to know.
  - In next month's meeting we should discuss this further with Danielle and plan the content of the grand rounds so it is as applicable as possible
  - Highlight that WISMHI provides trainings to clinics
  - The grand rounds will help them to prepare for the new HMO requirements
- Target start date is sometime in March
- ECCCS grant – Leah does not have the capacity to write this grant. Gail and Leah agree that for the amount of money it is not worth the effort
- Waisman is applying for a Robert Wood Johnson Community Solutions for Health Equity Grant with Hector Portillo of Padres e Hijos. It is proving to be a great opportunity to work together with the Latino community on health equity. The application is due Feb 1<sup>st</sup>, will find out if we got it on Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>
