Notes:

- CYSHCN Equity Group
 - This family equity work group starts next week and will meet every other month
 - Will explore whether people have the capacity to engage in activity every month – on months with no equity group meeting Katie will do webinar and there will be activities for members to complete
 - Purpose is to:
 - Learn together
 - Reflect on what we learn
 - Apply what we learn
 - Primarily people from CYSHCN Network, but have invited outside people doing relevant work – about 25 people have expressed interest in participating
 - Katie Ham from UWM will facilitate group. She has experience engaging diverse group on topics related to health equity
- Robert Wood Johnson Grant
 - Just submitted yesterday
 - \$300,000 over 3 years
 - Will find out Feb 22nd if grant will be awarded
 - Work would start April 1st
 - It is a partnership with Padres e Hijos (Hector Portillo's non-profit) - they needed UW to partner with them to apply to the grant
 - The focus of the grant is community organizing
 - Year 1 is recruitment, engagement, training
 - Year 2 is community conversations, learning and organizing
 - Year 3 ensuring conversations about developmental concerns are happening between Latino families and their health care providers
 - A number of partner agencies would be involved, including Family Voices
 - Regardless of outcome, it has been a great opportunity to build capacity in grant writing and develop connections
- Supplemental Needs Assessment – Learning from Black families
 - Barbara has been in communication with a Black pastor, Donna Bryant, about developing relationships/trust with Black families in Dane County – mistrust of Dane County services is comparatively high in the Black community – Barbara has reached out to Gail to see if there's a role for Ida on this
 - Ida and Meshan (LEND trainees) are very interested in this topic for their practica – they would like to dedicate their 80 practica to help us get something initiated
 - Possible next step may be to pull together a group of Black families on a Zoom call to identify systemic changes that need to be made
 - Meshan and Ida have meetings with Gail and Meredith for a broader LEND meeting on Fridays at 11a – Barbara will join 11-11:30a this Friday to discuss how to best move forward – Meredith will send Barbara the LEND meeting invite
- What we can be doing together in this group

- The goal of this group is broader than just education. We want trainings to be responsive and accessible to underrepresented groups
- The Family Voices video fact sheets are something we could collaborate on to make more accessible and responsive to underserved communities
 - We could create multiple versions of the videos with people from different communities and languages – Hmong, Latino,
 - Family voices has some great videos on their website from Connecticut — <https://familyvoiceswi.org/resource-library/> under Equity and Diversity
 - Next video topics will be vaccines and Birth to 3
 - Birth to 3 would be a great topic for us to collaborate on from the beginning
 - WSPEI is trying to get a B to 3 to Early Childhood warm hand off document done.
 - Deb Rothmoro (sp?) from the Covid19 Act Early supplement is working on promoting Birth to 3 in a uniform way – she is working on a PSA. It would be good for us to coordinate
